AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IRENE, SD, AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF IRENE BY AMENDING SECTION 10.08, OTHER PERMITTED SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF IRENE, SD:

Section 1. That Section 10.08, of the Zoning Regulations of Irene, SD is hereby renamed and amended to read as follows:

10.08 Temporary Signs

The following rules apply to all temporary signs unless otherwise specified herein:

- 1. No sign may be located within or overhang a public right-of-way or sidewalk.
- 2. No sign may interfere with visibility at an intersection or driveway as defined in Section 10.02.
- 3. No sign face area shall exceed:
 - a. 40 square feet in the R-1 and R-2 Districts; or
 - b. 100 square feet in the A, CB, GB, I-1, and I-2 Districts.
- 4. A sign shall be removed if it becomes torn, faded, or otherwise damaged.
- 5. A sign shall be securely attached to a sign support or building.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IRENE, SD, AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF IRENE BY AMENDING SECTION 18.02, DEFINITIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF IRENE, SD:

Section 1. That Section 18.02, of the Zoning Regulations of Irene, SD is hereby amended to include the following definitions:

18.02 Definitions

SIGN – Any object, device, display, or structure, or part thereof, situated outdoors or visible from outdoors, which is used to identify, display, direct, or attract attention to an object, person, institution, organization, business, product, service, event, or location by any means, including words, letters, figures, design, symbols, fixtures, colors, illumination, or projected images. This definition does not include national or state flags or their emblem or insignia, interior window displays, athletic scoreboards, or signs required or erected by governmental entities.
