

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IRENE, SD, AMENDING THE REVISED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY AMENDING TITLE 8, MUNICIPAL UTILITIES, CHAPTER 8.01, GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 8.0102, DEPOSIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF IRENE, SD:

Section 1. That Section 8.0102 of the Revised Municipal Ordinances of Irene, SD, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.0102 Deposit. Along with the application for utility service, the applicant therefore shall pay a utility deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Utility deposits shall be maintained in a separate account and held as security for the payment of municipal utility bills. The utility deposit shall be considered a combined utility deposit for the benefit of any and all municipal utilities received by the customer. The utility deposit may be returned to the customer after two years of good standing as a utility service customer. A customer of good standing requires that there be a zero balance at the time of request for the deposit to be returned and that at no time has the customer been delinquent in its payments of its utility bills for the City of Irene. The utility deposit amount may be adjusted by resolution of the City Council.
